## Instructions on the correct use of the attributes in the "Subject Distinguished Name" in E-Mail ID Gold Certificates

When creating a Certificate Signing Request (CSR) or the CMC parameters (or when entering the parameters in the GUI), the attributes or fields in the Subject Distinguished Name (SDN) must be filled in correctly to comply with regulatory requirements (and to prevent the request from being rejected by the CA system).

E-Mail ID Gold certificates are issued to a person who is a representative of an organization (typically an employee). The relevant attributes for identification in the SDN are: "Common Name" (CN), "emailAddress" (E), "Organization" (O), "StateOrProvince" (ST) and "Country" (C).

The following basic rules must be followed:

Other attributes, such as "Organizational Unit" (OU) for departments should be omitted.

The correct handling of the CMC interface is described in the document "<u>Technical Specification</u> <u>CMC Interface</u>".

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Regardless of the emailAddress attribute in the SDN, the email address must always be included in the "Subject Alternative Name" (SAN) extension of an email certificate.
