


How to request a new certificate with a voucher code on swissign.net?

This short guide will walk you through the process of requesting a new certificate with a voucher code we have sent you by e-mail.


To redeem this voucher code and request a new certificate **free of charge**, please proceed as follows:

1. Go to <https://swissign.net/mpki/request> and click on “Logon” or “Proceed without account” if you do not have an account yet.





6. With SSL certificates you have an option to choose between “Pre-Certificate” and “OCSP-Stapling” methods. We recommend the option “Pre-Certificate”. The “OCSP-Stapling” method can trigger a security warning in the Safari and Chrome browsers.

Certificate Transparency

“Certificate Transparency” (CT) means that a Certificate Authority like SwissSign has to publish all its publicly trusted SSL/TLS-certificates into public databases, so called CT-logs. The according confirmations of the CT-logs may be published as a part of the certificate (“pre-certificate”) or via Online Certificate Status Protocol (OCSP) or “OCSP-Stapling” respectively (“stapling”). As CT over OCSP-Stapling may lead to warning messages with certain combinations of operating systems and browsers we strongly recommend to choose the option “pre-certificate”.

Important: The option “pre-certificate” for certificate issuance does not preclude the setting of “OCSP-Stapling” on the webserver.

7. When requesting SSL Silver certificates, you can select one of five e-mail addresses to confirm your domain. Please be aware that a confirmation e-mail will be sent to this e-mail address.

8. Depending on the certificate type (SSL or e-mail), a window with the corresponding information will be displayed in the next step.
 - a. If you are requesting an SSL certificate, click “Request certificate”.

- b. If you are requesting an e-mail certificate without CSR, you will need to set a password for your certificate first. Please remember this password as it will not be possible to reset it later.

9. After submitting the request, you will see a short summary as well as the next steps for activating your certificate.

- **For E-Mail Silver certificates**, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to the e-mail address associated with the certificate.
- **For SSL Silver certificates**, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to the e-mail address you have chosen in the previous step.
- **For SSL Gold certificates**, you will receive a random value to activate your domain(s). In addition, you will receive an application form which must be filled out, signed and sent to the SwissSign Fulfilment Center:
